

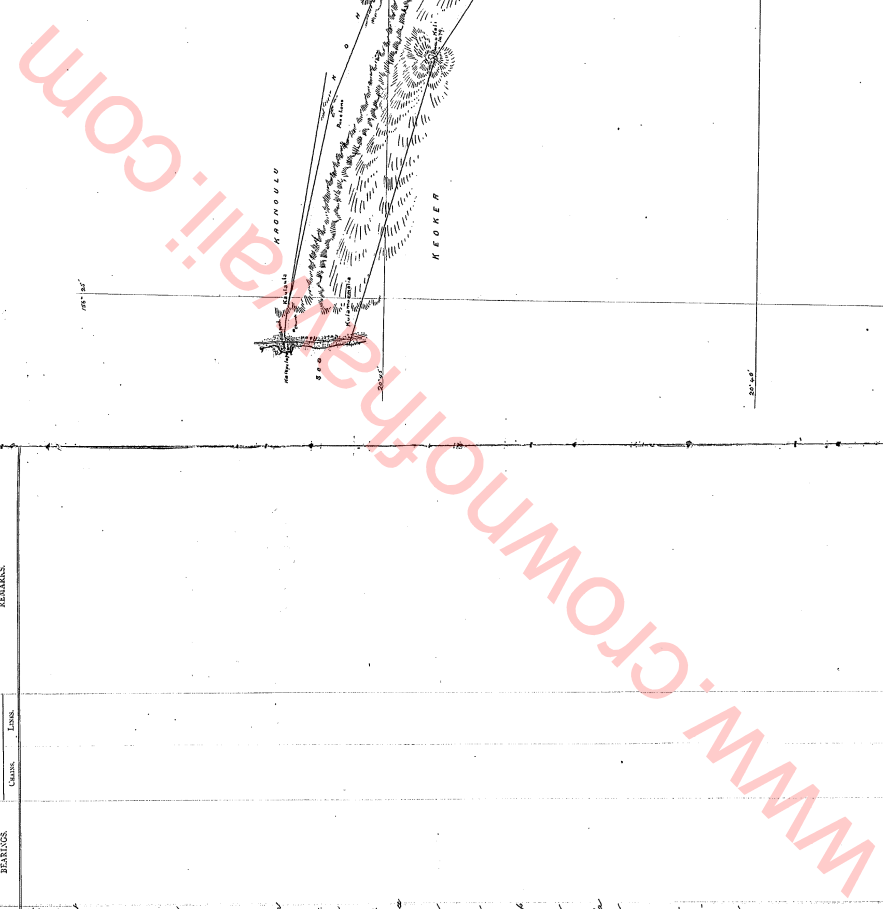

7,116.63' S. 61' W.		along Kihaka to a pile of stones on a hillside.				
8,116.70' S. 51' W.		along Kihaka to a stone marker.
